

Balance :- placement of objects so that it creates visual equilibrium.

- i) Symmetrical / Formal Balance :-
mirror image of parts on each side of a center point
- ii) Asymmetrical / Informal Balance :-
different objects on either side of a central point.
- iii) Radial Balance :-
balance created from a central point, radiating outward.

Rhythm :- continuous movement, the path the eye follows.

- i) by Repetition :- shapes, forms, lines or colours that are repeated in a design
- ii) by Gradation:- sizes of shapes go from large to small or colour values go from light to dark.
- iii) by Radiation:- objects radiate out in nearly every direction from a central point
- iv) by opposition:- abrupt change in any of the elements.
- v) by Transition:- a subtle, visual flow e.g- spiral staircase often indicated by a curved line that leads the eye from one point or area to another.
